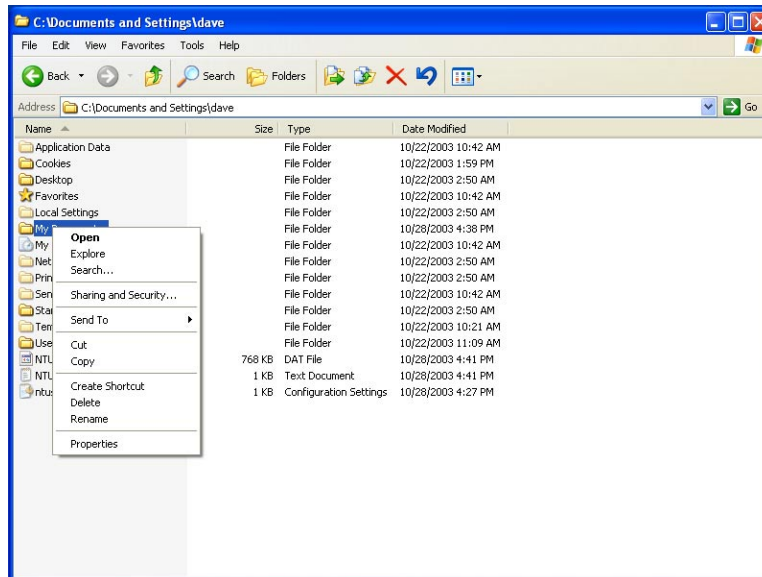

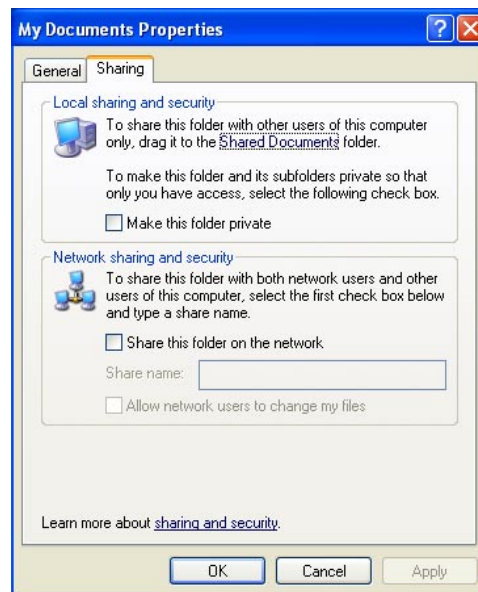
## Sharing Files from Windows XP Professional to the Roku HD1000

In order for your HD1000 to access files on your computer, those files must be shared via the Windows File Sharing protocol. This document outlines the steps required to share files on a Windows Xp Professional computer using this method.

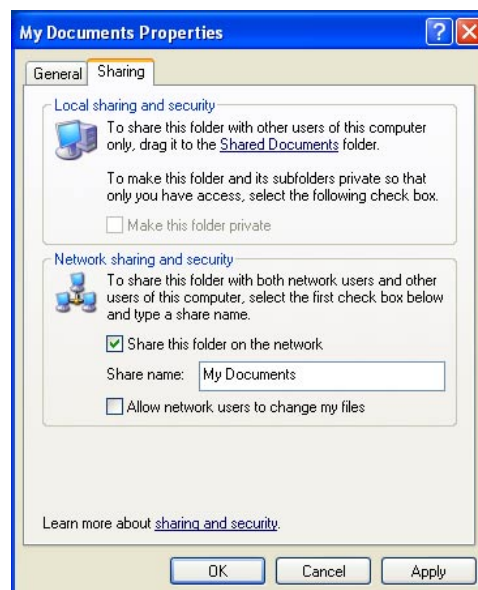
First, using the Windows Explorer, locate the directory to be shared. In this case, it is the “My Documents” folder for a fictional user named “dave”. Next, right-click on the directory to display a popup menu:



Click on the “Sharing and Security...” menu item to bring up the sharing panel for the selected directory:



Click in the checkbox labeled “Share this folder on the network” to enable sharing. If you wish to allow the HD1000 to copy files to this folder, also choose the “Allow network users to change my files” checkbox. **Note: Doing this will also allow other people on your network to delete files in the directory.**



Click the “OK” button to dismiss the dialog and confirm your changes. At this point, your HD1000 should be able to access the files contained in the directory that was just shared.
